New Rules of Professional Conduct

After almost 14 months of review and revisions, the California Supreme Court has released the long-awaited new Rules of Professional Conduct.

There are a number of revisions, including the expansion of the definition of "legal matter" as it pertains to conflicts, making conflicts more broad and less case specific. There is also now a provision which requires "all law firm lawyers the responsibility to advocate corrective action to address known harassing or discriminatory conduct by the firm or any of its lawyers or nonlawyer personnel."

THE MCBA EXTENDS CONGRATULATIONS TO MERCED COUNTY'S NEWEST SUPERIOR COURT JUDGES!

Governor Brown has appointed Shelly A. Seymour and Steven K. Slocum as Superior Court Judges.

Judge Seymour served as a Commissioner at the Merced County Superior Court from 2014 to 2018, where she was a facilitator and self-help attorney from 2008 to 2013. She also served as a Commissioner at the Mariposa County Superior Court from 2012 to 2014. After graduating law school, Judge Seymour initially worked for a law firm before establishing her own office as a sole practitioner from 1997 to 2003, with an emphasis in Family Law.



Judge Slocum has served as a Commissioner at the Merced County Superior Court since January 2018. He served in several positions at the Merced County District Attorney's Office from 2005 to 2018, including Supervising Deputy District Attorney, after working for a law firm from 2002 to 2005. Judge Slocum earned a Juris Doctor degree from the Pepperdine University School of Law, and his undergraduate degree from University of California, Los Angeles.
