## RUSSEL COOK TO PROVIDE MCLE COURSE ON MEDIATION

At our May 13, 2021 meeting, Russel Cook will be providing a course on mediation which has been approved by the California State Bar for one hour of MCLE credit. The presentation will be by webinar, and there is no cost to attend.

As an attorney since 1980, and an attorney and mediator since 1992, Mr. Cook has conducted in excess of 700 mediations involving all aspects of civil litigation, including construction, business disputes, personal injury, medical malpractice, and other claims.



He has also conducted a number of arbitrations, including a 6-day arbitration involving real estate fraud, real estate financing, appraisal issues, broker liability, duty to disclose claim in excess of \$1 million dollars.

Over 40 years he has tried in excess of 100 civil cases to verdict or decision. During that same time, he has resolved or settled over 3,000 cases while representing one of the parties to the dispute. Mr. Cook has represented over 1,000 litigants involved in personal injury claims (both plaintiff and defense), and has represented plaintiffs in a class action claim involving pensioner's benefits which resolved for \$5,600,000,00.
